Dear Mr. Harvey:

I grant your December 16, 2016 request for Algonquin Gas Transmission, LLC (Algonquin) to place into service the Stony Point to Yorktown Take-up and Relay from mileposts 2.6 to 5.5 of the Algonquin Incremental Market Project in Rockland and Westchester Counties, New York. This authorization enables you to provide the remaining 97,000 dekatherms per day of incremental firm transportation service.

Your request is in compliance with environmental condition 10 of the Commission's March 3, 2015 *Order Issuing Certificate* (Order) issued in the above-referenced docket. Based on our daily third-party compliance monitor field inspections, rehabilitation and stabilization of the construction work areas for these facilities are proceeding satisfactorily and are currently in compliance with the terms of the Order.¹
